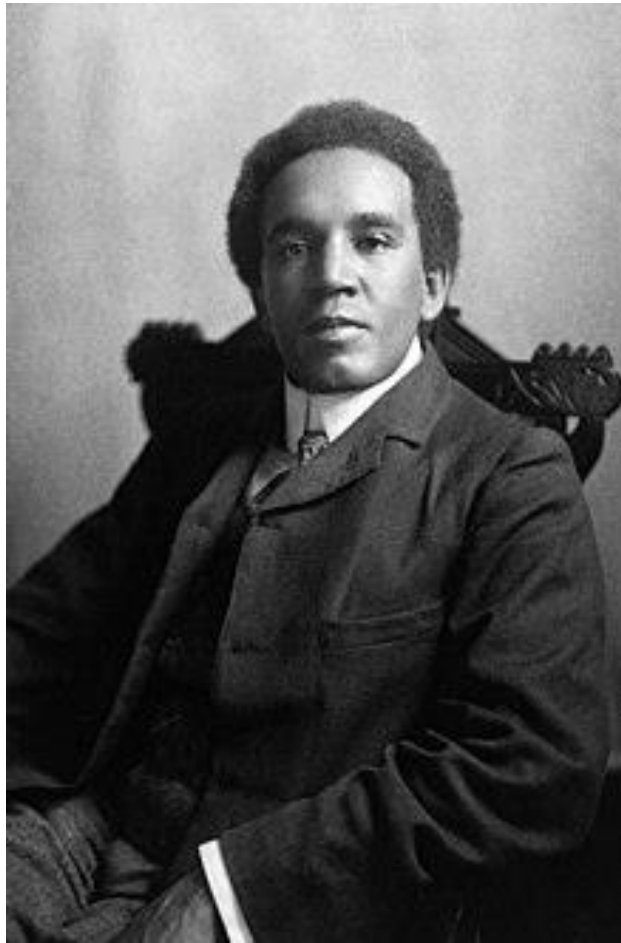


## Samuel Coleridge-Taylor



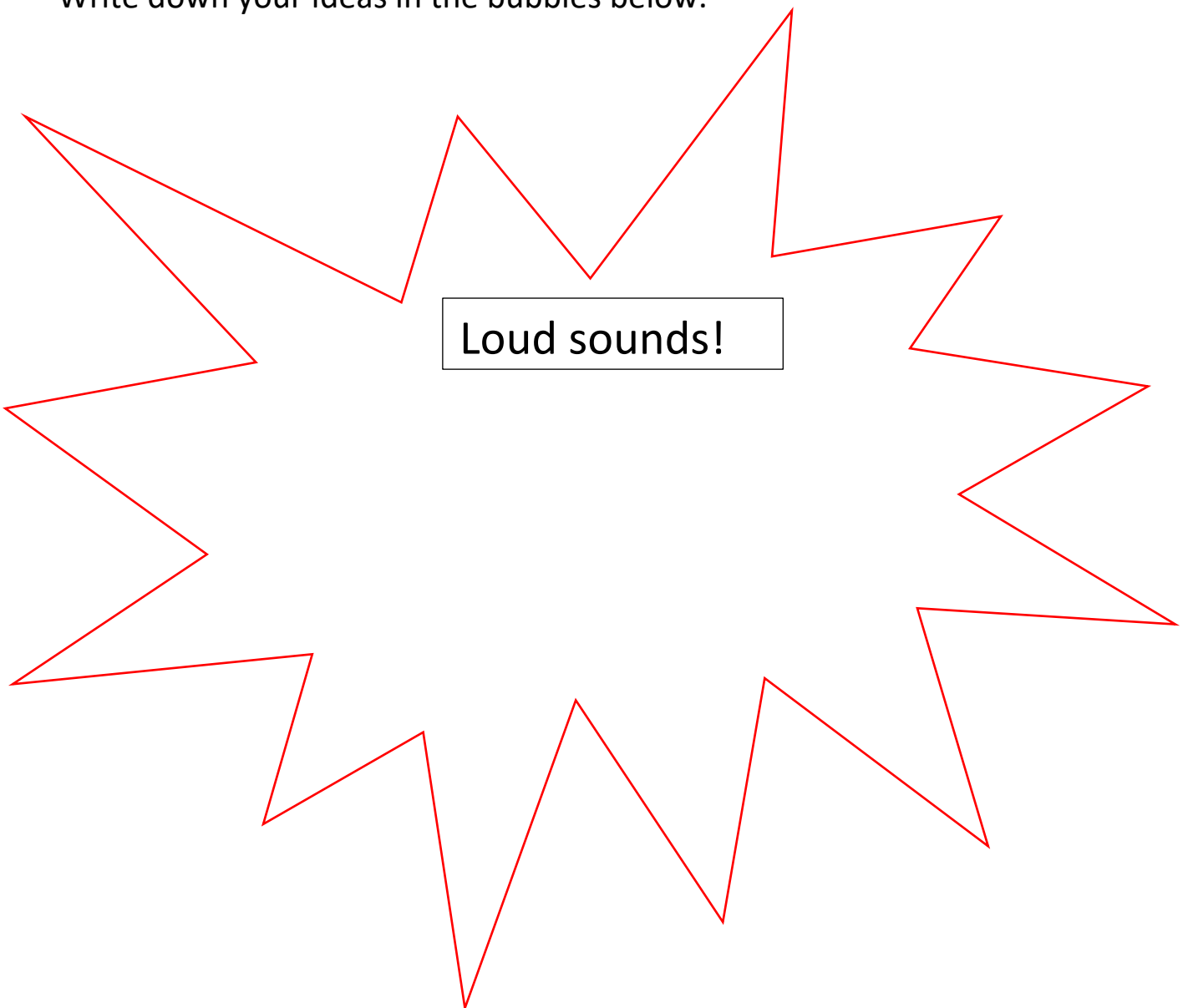
### Top 5 facts!

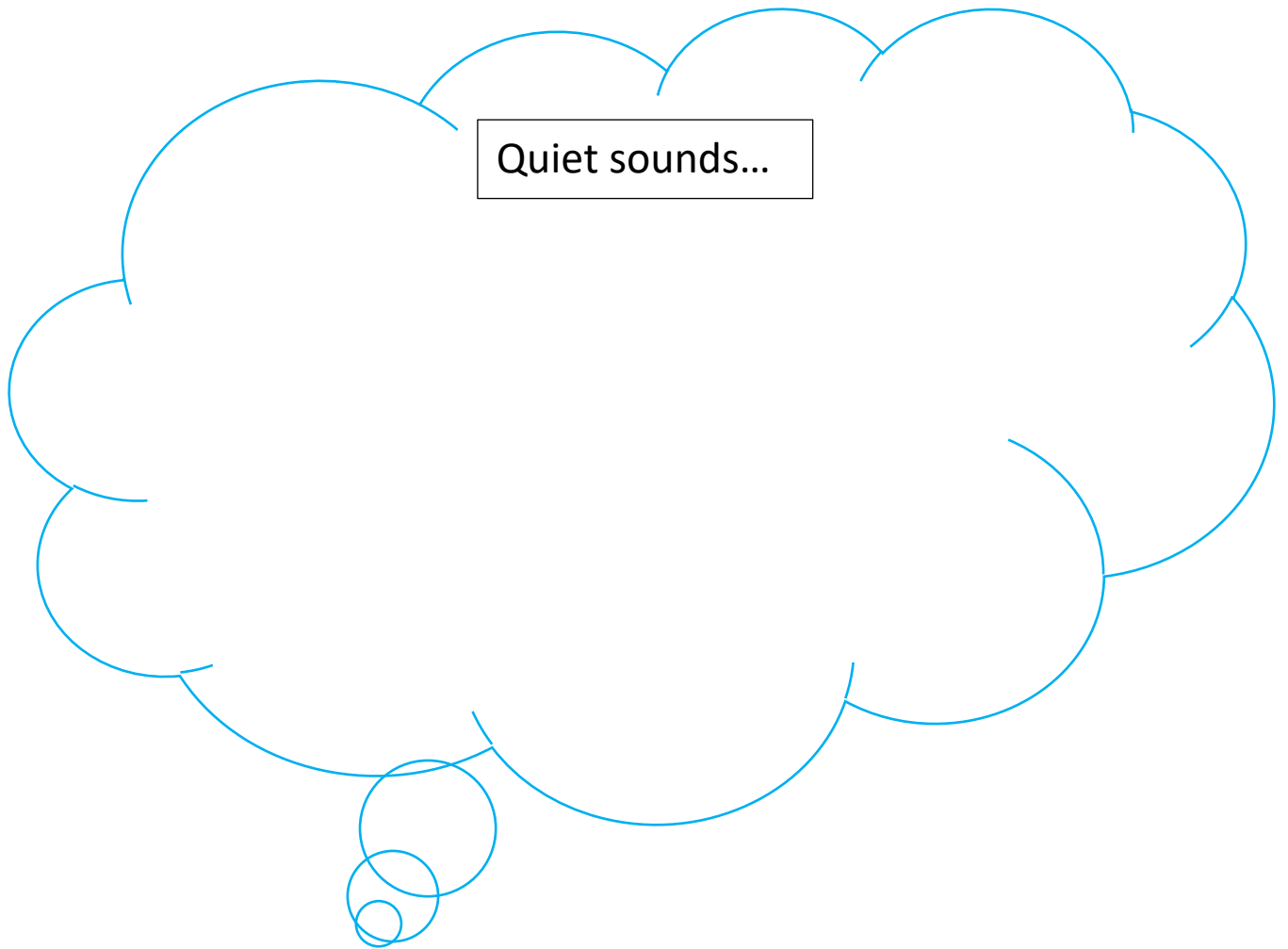
- Born in 1875 and died in 1912
- He was of dual heritage; his mother was English and his dad was from Sierra Leone.
- He had two children, both who went onto become composers too.
- He studied at the Royal College of Music, first on violin and then he switched to composition.
- One of his most famous compositions is Hiawatha's Wedding Feast. This became so popular that Coleridge-Taylor was able to tour in the USA, and he even met President Theodore Roosevelt at the White House!
